



Well Visits and Additional Concerns Policy

Your child's yearly checkup focuses on growth, development, vaccines and preventative care.

Most insurance plans cover this visit at no cost to you.

Sometimes families also want the provider to evaluate medical concerns during the same appointment (examples: anxiety, ADHD, asthma symptoms, headaches, sleep problems, stomach pain, rashes, constipation, or medication management).

When a medical concern is evaluated or treated, insurance requires us to bill it as a separate medical service in addition to the checkup. Your insurance may apply a copayment, coinsurance, or deductible for that portion of the visit.

We always try to take care of everything in one visit for your convenience, but you may request a separate appointment if you prefer the check up to remain preventative-only.
